


Movie Time!



Many people like to watch movies. You can see movies at a theater. You can also watch them on television or on a phone.


What kinds of movies do you like? Some are about animals. Other movies are about space travel.

Block the Shot!

These mountains are called the Sierra Nevada. There you can see forests, rivers, and lakes. Lake Tahoe is a large, deep lake.






People like to hike in the Sierra Nevada Mountains. Some trails are so long they can take 2 or 3 weeks to hike!
